

**Amendments to the Articles of Incorporation of  
the Nevada Inventors Association, Inc**

Articles IV and IX of the Articles of Incorporate of the Nevada Inventors Association, Inc shall be replaced with the articles listed below.

**Article IV**

Purpose

A. General Purpose. Subject to the provisions of paragraphs B. and C. of this Article IV and such other restrictions as the Trustees may impose, the Corporation may engage in educational activities.

B. Educational Purposes. The Corporation is organized exclusively for educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, the Corporation shall carry on no activity not permitted to be carried by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or any corresponding or substitute statute).

C. Specific Purposes. The specific purposes of the Corporation include, are listed below:

1. To educate inventors on U.S. and International Intellectual Property;
2. To educate Inventors on the entrepreneurial process;
3. To educate Inventors on the scientific process;
4. To educate Inventors on current scientific and technological advances.

**Article IX**

Dissolution

Upon the dissolution of this Corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code (or corresponding section of any future tax code), or shall be distributed to such one or more charitable organizations or foundations whose purposes are compatible with those set forth in Article IV (C) above. In the absence of such designation by the Board of Trustees, the assets shall be distributed to a nonprofit corporation originated pursuant to the laws of Nevada.
